



IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME SUBJECTS Group 1: Studies in language and literature

Language A Literature

- The course introduces students to the analysis of literary texts.
- It is available in 55 languages and also by special request.
- Students study their mother tongue (also referred to as first or native language) - their most competent language.
- Polish students study Polish A Literature.
- It is available at higher and standard levels (HL or SL).
- Students study 13 literary works at higher level and 9 and standard level.
- The texts studied include works written in students' mother tongue and works translated into their mother tongue from other languages.
- The course is aimed to develop the ability of detailed analysis of literary works and understanding of the techniques involved in literary criticism.
- Students are assessed on the basis of:
- Formal examinations (Paper 1: an analysis of a passage of unseen literary text and Paper 2: a comparative response to a question based on two works studied).
- Individual oral assessment presenting their analysis of two works studied.
- In case of HL also a 1200-1500 word **essay** on one of the works studied.
